# *Toxic or not? Ohio Air Quality*

**Supervisor, Air Toxics Unit, Ohio Environmental Protection Agency**

Mr. Koval will discuss issues related to the Clean Air Act, 1990, and the program through which the Ohio EPA regulates air quality in Ohio. He has supervised the program since 1992 and has overseen many changes in both state and federal ways of maintaining the air we breathe. He will discuss common air pollution elements and how control, monitoring and state level negotiations have improved air quality in Ohio. It is important to note that despite this effort, Ohio air quality is one of the worst in the nation.
